Overview

MnDOT is conducting a study of the Hwy 14 and Highland Avenue intersection in New Ulm to analyze safety and mobility issues. With input from the city of New Ulm, local residents and businesses, the school district, and other project stakeholders, MnDOT will evaluate the intersection, develop design alternatives, and arrive at a preferred layout in an effort to secure funding for a future safety improvement project.

Opportunity for Public Input


