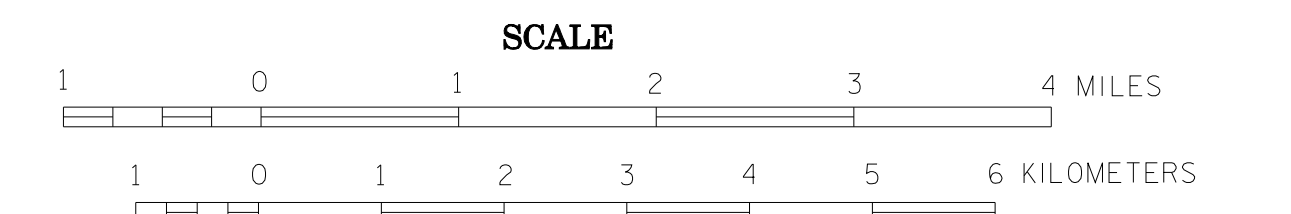


2004 TRUNK HIGHWAY VOLUMES
GENERAL HIGHWAY MAP

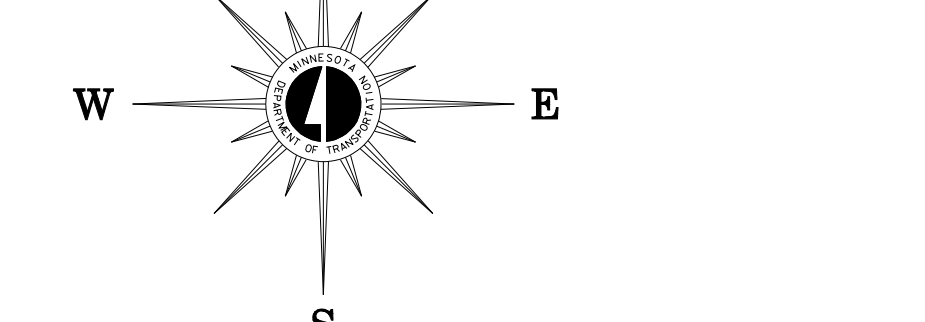

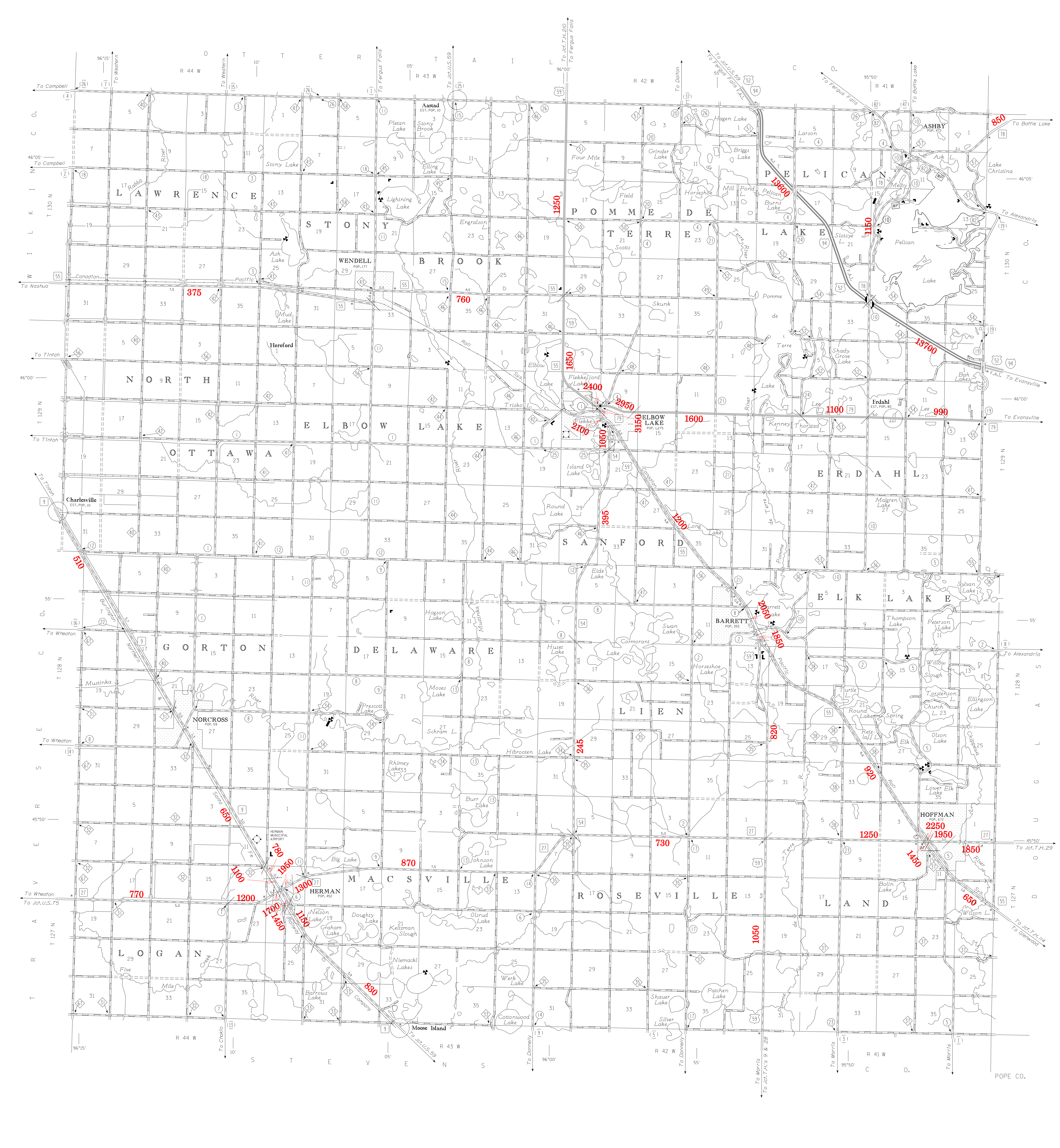

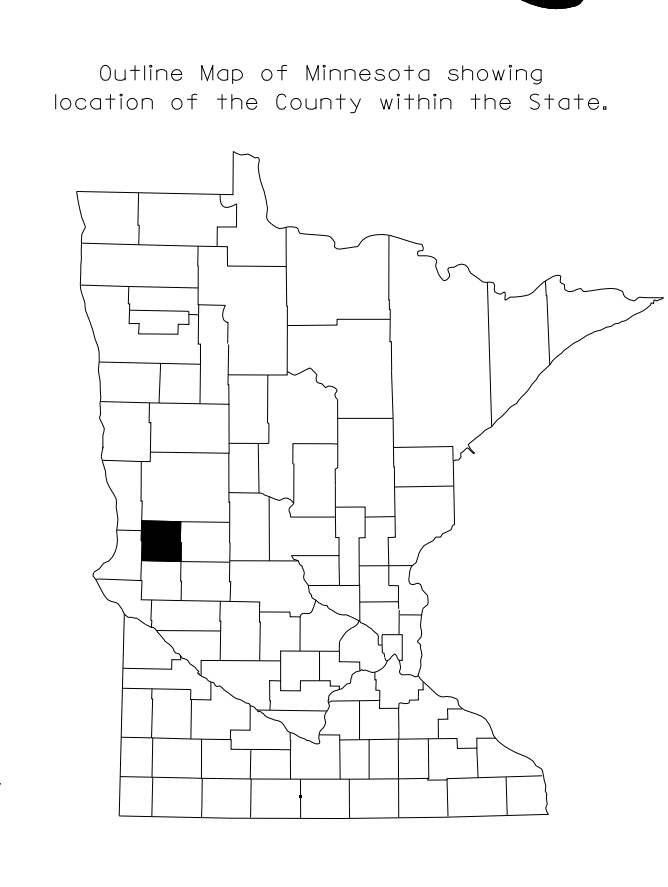
